Sergeant Richard Geiger proudly served his communities through the emergency services arena for over 37 years, which included 26 years with the West Goshen Police Department. In July 2013, Richard was diagnosed with glioblastoma multiforme and lost his courageous battle in July 2014.

A glioblastoma is a tumor that arises from astrocytes—the star-shaped cells that make up the “glue-like,” or supportive tissue of the brain. These tumors are usually highly malignant (cancerous) because the cells reproduce quickly and they are supported by a large network of blood vessels.
